Intensive Coaching Program (ICP) for Melb High, Mac Rob & Berwick High 2009

Aim

In this course we aim to prepare students for the entrance exam into Melbourne High, Mac Robertson Girls High & Berwick High on 13/06/2009. The ICP is very intensive, designed to help students to practice sample tests including essay writing. It is recommended for students at year levels of 7, 8 and 9. The ICP is well-known as it has always achieved excellent results for many years (we had 64 students achieved above cut-off score in 2008).

How to enroll in the ICP

First of all, students are required to take our ICP Entrance Exam, which will be held at the University of Melbourne on Saturday of 11/04/2009. To register, you need to fill in a form which is available from our campuses, or website www.vieonline.com.au. After lodging the form, you would receive information about one week before the exam.

What to be tested in the ICP Entrance Exam

In this test, we aim to provide students to practice a formal exam which is conducted in the same way as the actual exam in term of level of difficulty and testing environment. The actual exam paper is developed by an educational psychologist employed by Victorian Department of Education. An Exam Information Booklet which contains sample questions will be sent to registered students about one week prior to the exam.

The whole exam consists of SIX component tests which would be set in the following order:

| 1. Verbal Reasoning (30 minutes) | - Multiple choice questions. |
| 2. Numerical Reasoning (30 minutes) | - Multiple choice questions. |
| 3. Analytical Written Expression (15 minutes) | - Students are given an issue for writing. |
| 4. Reading Comprehension (30 minutes) | - Multiple choice questions. |
| 5. Mathematics (30 minutes) | - Multiple choice questions. |
| 6. Creative Written Expression (15 minutes) | - Students are given a visual stimulus to write. |

What will happen after ICP Entrance Exam:

We will send you a letter of results and instructions how to enroll the ICP within seven days after the exam. If a student passed this exam, he/she would get an offer and be eligible to attend ICP. If you wish to secure a place, you should pay the course fee by 18/4 at Flemington or net-bank transfer to our account. Students are ranked at different levels from A to E based on their exam performance. A is the highest ranking. (We advise parents that students who rank at levels of D & E would hardly find a chance to pass the initial cut-off score prior to gain an offer from Melbourne High, Mac Robertson Girls High or Berwick High school.)

When does the ICP start and for how long?

ICP is scheduled for seven classes over seven Sundays from 26/4 to 7/6/2009, and will be held at:

* **FLEMINGTON: (9.30AM - 12.30PM) IN THE MORNING** * **RICHMOND: (1.30PM - 4.30PM) IN AFTERNOON**

Each class has 3 hour duration, taught by experienced trainers who specialize to each area of study:

SECTION 1. Verbal Reasoning & Reading Comprehension (1 hour) - Ms Melanie Westbrook

SECTION 2. Numerical Reasoning & Mathematics (1 hour) - Ms Evelyn Laurens

SECTION 3. Analytical & Creative Written Expression (1 hour) - Ms Katrina Witt

Students will be given seven Sample Tests over seven Sundays. For each set of the sample tests, it contains three component tests on three different areas of study. Each component test has 30' duration.

What is the actual exam date this year (for Melbourne High, Mac Rob and Berwick High)

The Year 9 Entrance Exam for entry Melbourne High, Mac Robertson Girls and Berwick High is scheduled on Saturday, June 13th, 2009 at Royal Exhibition Buildings in Carlton Gardens.

How students are selected

Students who passed the initial cut-off score but not meet 5% Rule would be selected. Melbourne High, Mac Robertson Girls and Berwick High would select 308 boys, 225 girls and 200 boys and girls respectively. 5% Rule means the number of students being selected in each school will NOT exceed 5%. For example, if the school where Jim attends has one hundred Year 8 students then a maximum of 5 students would be selected. If Jim passed the cut-off score, but he ranked in the 6th position in his school, then Jim would meet 5% Rule. He might not get an offer in the 1st round, but entitle for reconsideration in 2nd round. Students can apply for two schools at a time at their preferences. Boys can apply for Melbourne High and Berwick High, while girls can apply for Mac Robertson Girls and Berwick High. The exam outcome will be posted to parents in early to mid-August.

To book for ICP Entrance Exam at Melbourne University on 11/04/2009, students MUST fill in a form and return to us by 01/04/2009 with \$45 testing fee by cash, cheque or money order. ICP forms are available from our website www.vieonline.com.au or at our campuses on the weekends. After lodging the form, you should receive an information letter, issued with Student Exam Number (SEN), one week before the exam.
